

The course booklet is written and by Canon John Young who worked for





This year Marlborough Churches Together is using the York Course: Receiving Christ in Five Different Ways:

'To all who received him ... he gave power to become children of God.' *(John 1.12.)*

This raises big questions. Aren't we all children of God anyway? Just how can we receive Christ? And what does it mean to have' a relationship with God'?

John Young teases out from the New Testament at least three different ways in which we receive Christ. John's course booklet is supplemented by four leading Christians, from a variety of backgrounds, on the course CD. Together they demonstrate that St John's theology in his magisterial Gospel has very practical implications for our day-to-day lives.
